1. Gough's Cave

Learn all about the largest of our showcaves; classed as a scheduled ancient monument after the discovery of Britain's oldest, most complete skeleton in 1903, known today as Cheddar Man.

Audio guides are available to help bring the cave to life. The tour lasts approximately 45 minutes; available in English, French, German, Russian, Polish and Mandarin.

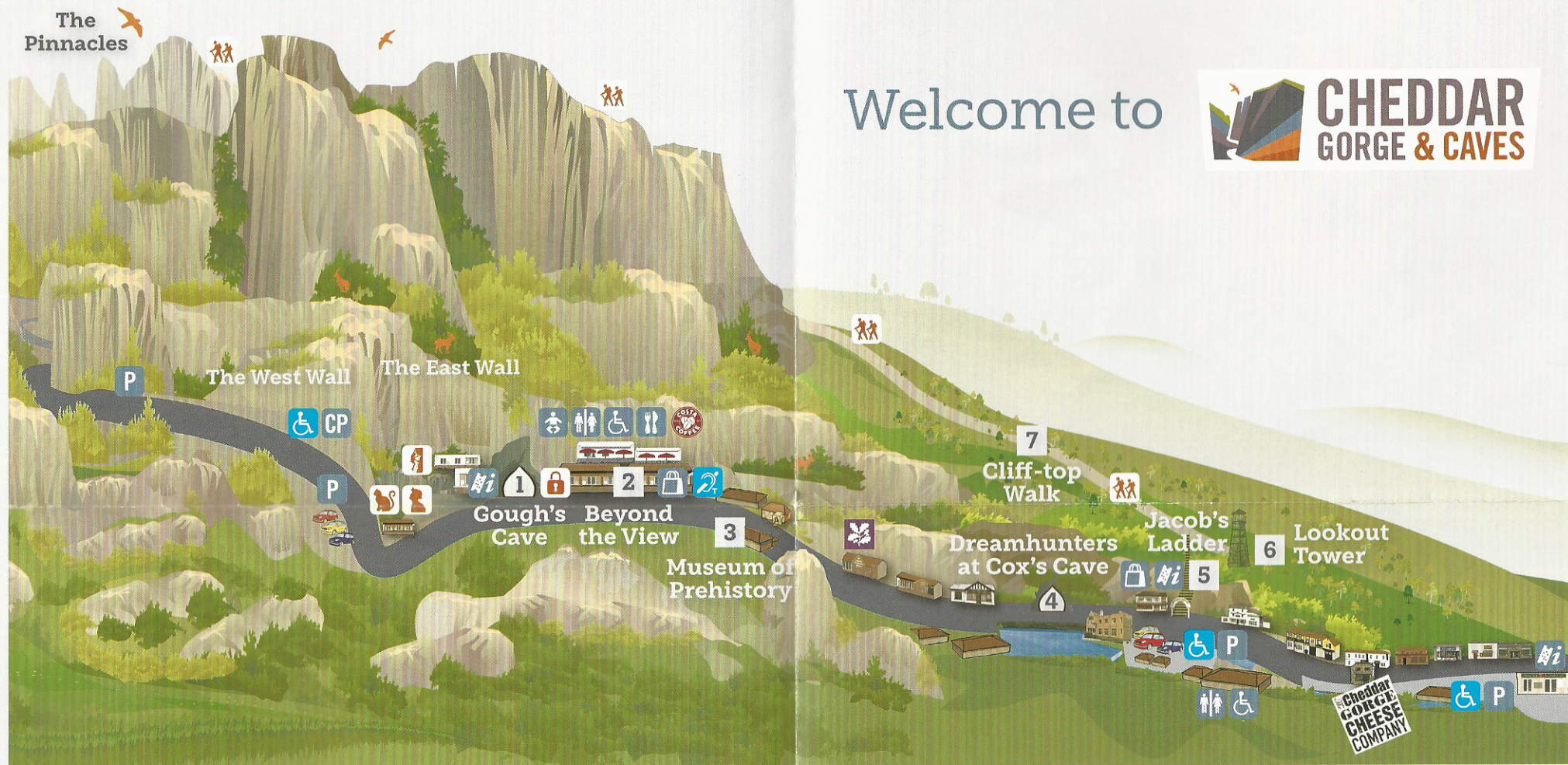
There are also braille and hearing induction loop options available.



2. Beyond the View

A cinematic journey through the gorge from a new perspective, with a 270-degree virtual tour.

This experience lasts approximately 15 minutes. Accessible entry is via the Escape Rooms Hub.

4. Dreamhunters at Cox's Cave

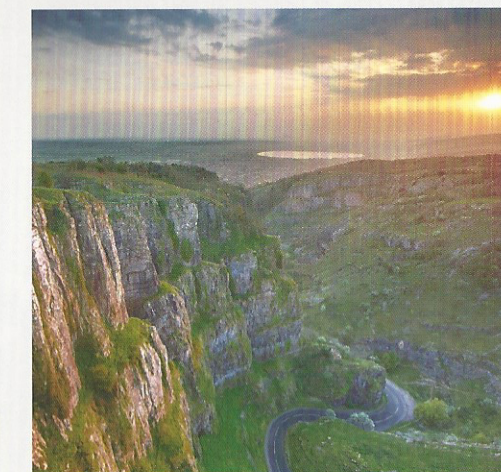
Walk in the footsteps of our ancestors as you discover the adventures of early man with this multimedia experience.

Lasts approximately 30 minutes and contains flashing lights, images and strobe lighting effects.



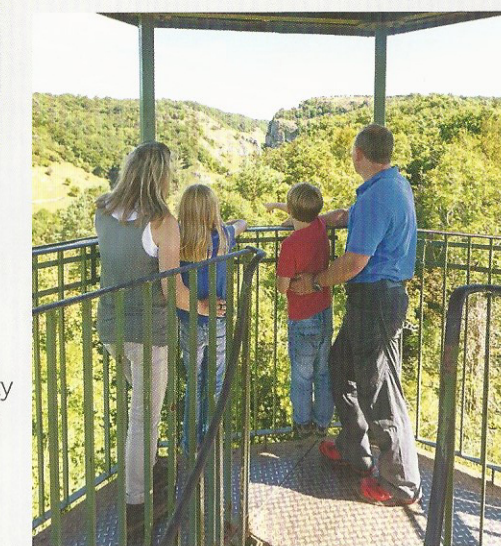
7. Cliff-top Walk
