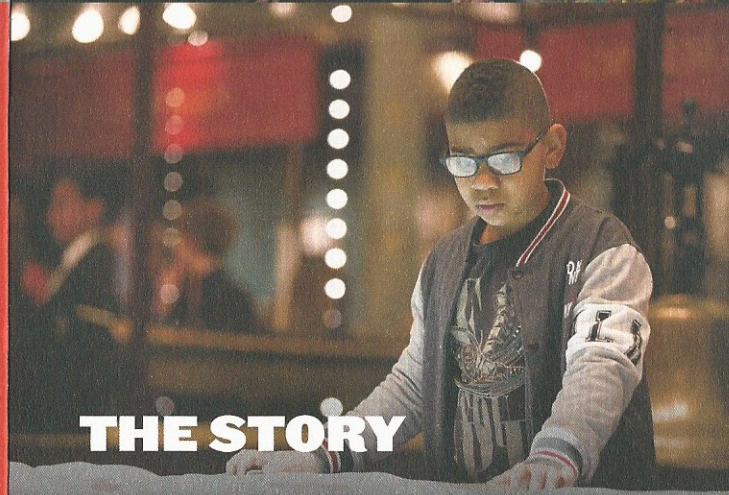

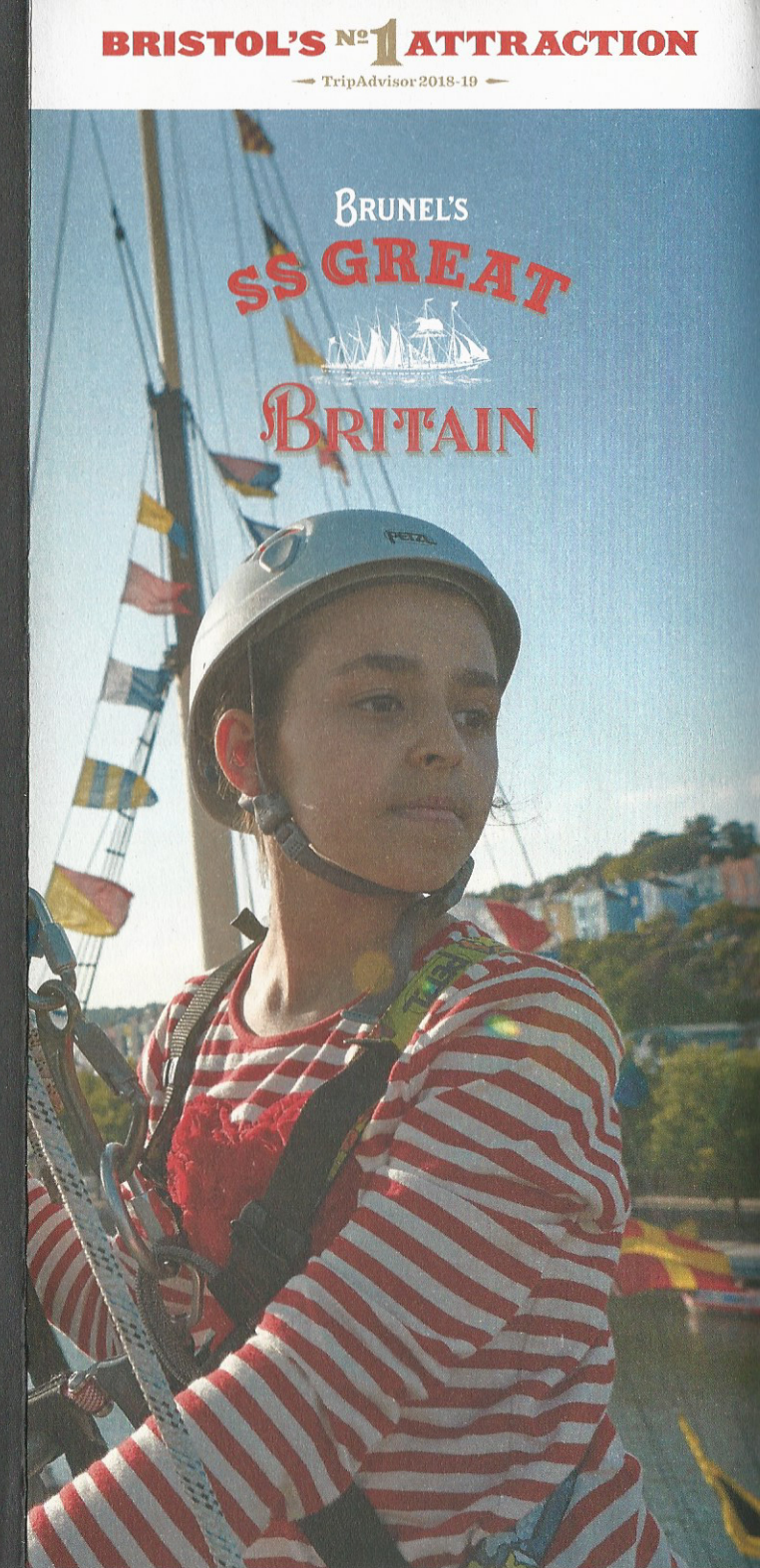

Step into the shoes of a Victorian sailor and climb the rigging of the SS Great Britain.

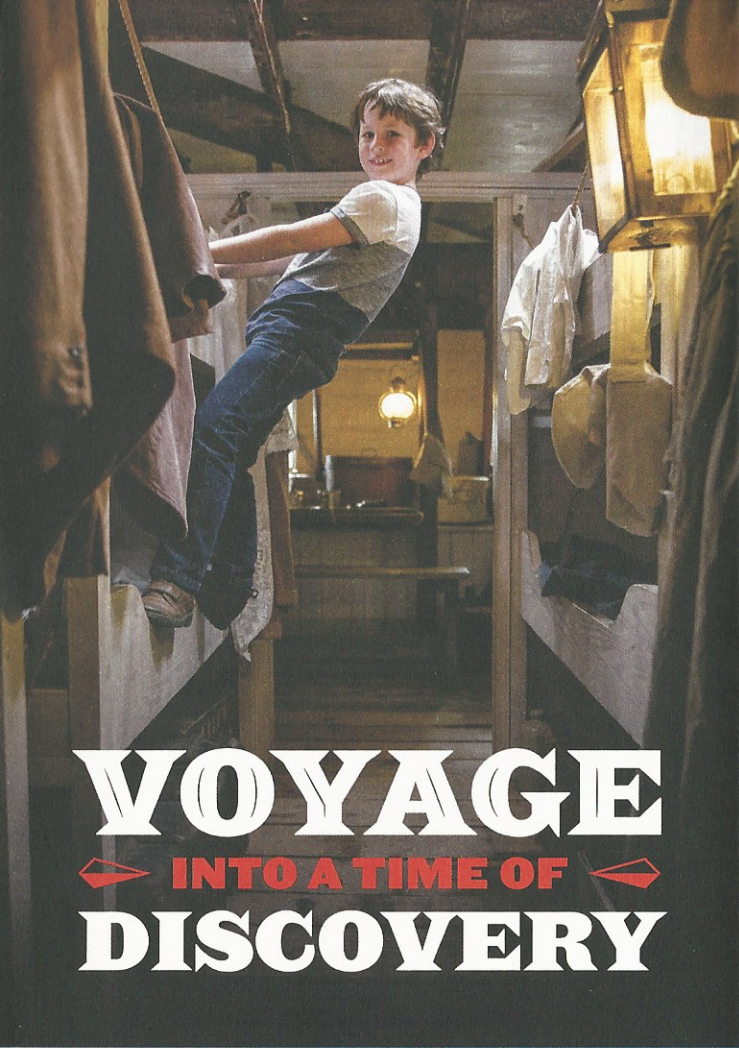

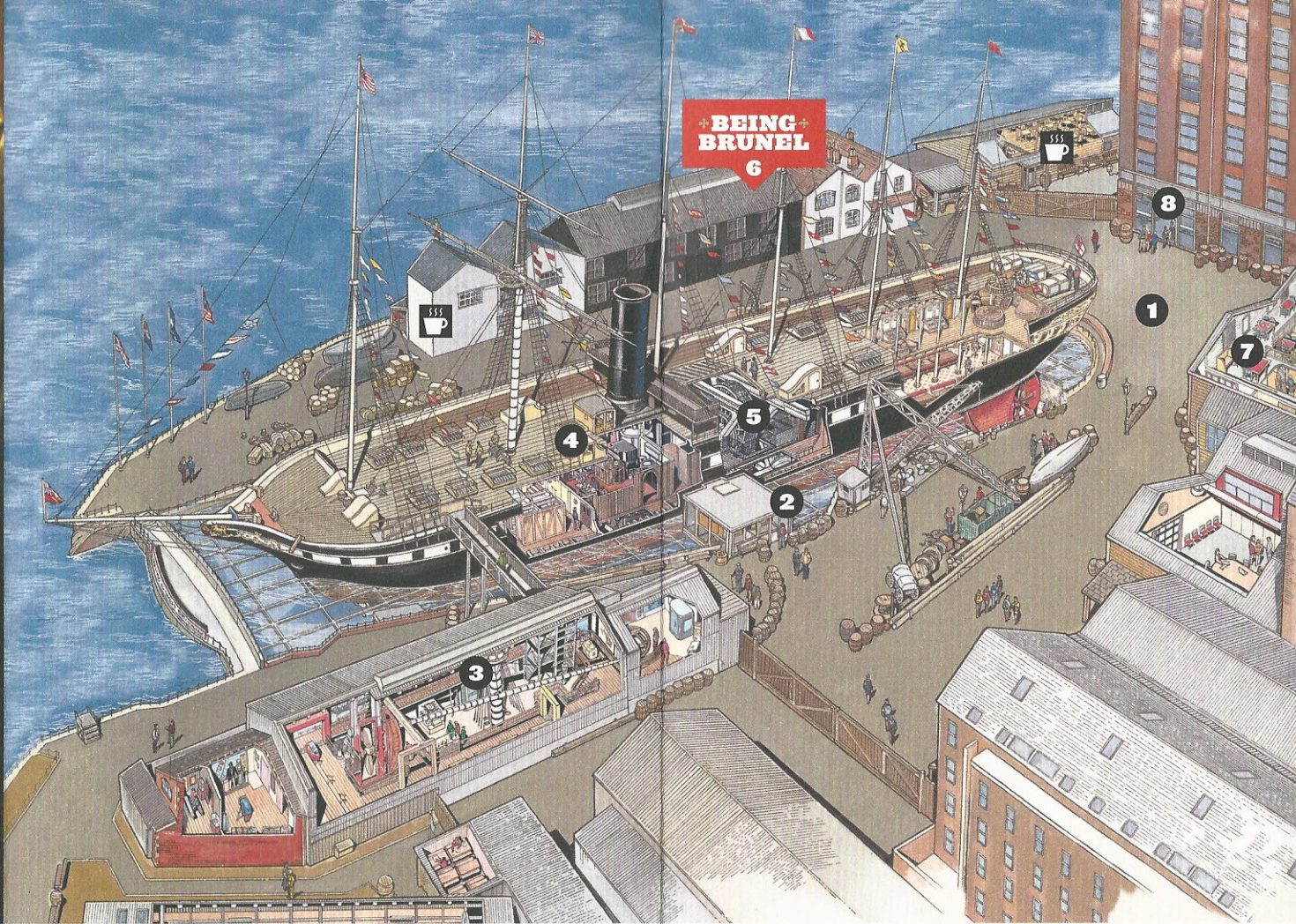

# DISCOVERY



## Discover the greatest innovation and the greatest mind of the Victorian age.

- 1 Wander through the **Great Western Dockyard**, the birthplace of the SS Great Britain. Come face to face with characters from the Victorian age in the lively dockside – you may even spot Mr. Brunel himself!
- 2 Hold your breath as you go underwater! Walk across the cobbles of the 1830s **Dry Dock** to marvel at the ship's original iron hull and revolutionary screw propeller.
- 3 Step back in time and discover the ship's history through immersive games and interactives. Dress up in authentic costumes and grab some Victorian-style photos, then pick up a **Boarding Card** and follow in the footsteps of a real passenger who travelled on board.

- 4 Become a Victorian sailor and scrub the decks, then don your harness and scale the rigging. Climb 25m up the mainmast and step out across the yardarm for the most spectacular view of Bristol. **Go Aloft!** is free for under-18s.
- 5 Delve **below deck** and experience the sights, sounds and smells of life at sea. Make your way through the luxury of first class, past the roar of the engine and into the cramped confines of steerage.
- 6 Discover an extraordinary mind in **Being Brunel** through an incredible array of interactive displays, games and artefacts.
- 7 Get closer to history with amazing access to original artefacts, letters and diaries in the **Brunel Institute**.
