

Burledge Hill Circular Walk

Approx distance 2.5 miles
Approx duration 1 to 1.5 hours



*A short'ish walk, but up and down!
Some off-road sections - good
footwear required.*

Leaving the site on foot, turn right up towards the Red Lion & main road, cross the main road & go straight across (past the pub) and up Sutton Hill Rd.

On leaving the village, just before the road appears to level off, take the footpath on the right, between two houses (just past the house called Hillside).

Follow the path upwards, then up some steps and as it levels off, you will see the trig point above and to your left, at 174m above sea level. From this location there are fine views of the lake.

Continue on footpath in same direction, going up through the kissing gate (not the field gate). This section can be slightly overgrown.

Take the next footpath on the right - it is slightly hidden in the bushes, but look out for steps and a handrail. Go through next kissing gate, then steeply downhill, in the direction on the marker post.

After the gap between the shrubbery and a big tree, continue downhill to the bottom left hand corner of the field, then through a final gate into the lane.

Follow lane down to the main road, then turn right to return to the start, where an ice cream or a pint awaits if you visit the Red Lion or the village stores.

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
